Application Deadline: On-going

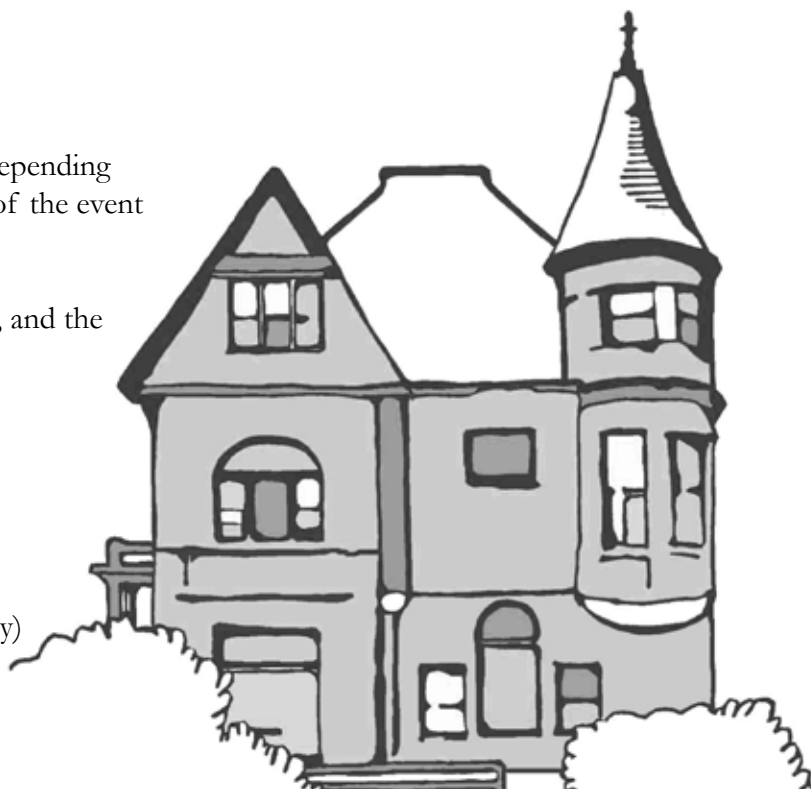
Rate of Pay: \$75 - \$150 per event depending upon the complexity of the event
